Girls Soccer Takes Home the Title!

On Friday, November 4, the Academy of Holy Angels (AHA) girls soccer team, led by Coach Dave Marshak, won the Class AA State Championship at U.S. Bank Stadium. It was a closely fought match against Mahtomedi, who was the number one ranked team and four-time defending State Champion heading into the final game. In the end, after a 1-1 tie in overtime, the game came down to a shoot-out. It was then that sophomore Briarleigh Dahl earned the game-winning goal to win the title, the program's second State Championship. Their first state title was in 2003.

Building Upon Previous Seasons

Coach Marshak, who also works as a social studies teacher at AHA, has been the head varsity coach

since 2007. The Stars girls soccer program - at all levels of play - has a strong reputation. The team has played in the last five consecutive State Tournaments and had two recent Miss Soccer players (Mia Van der Heide '20 in 2020 and Cat Duffy Shaw '21 in 2021).

Although they graduated some key players, the team was highly ranked all season. The Stars finished the regular season with a 20-2-0 record and continued to gel into the postseason, working with 14 returning players and eight new players, including three freshmen. At a recent send-off pep fest prior to the State Tournament, Coach Marshak commented, "It takes a lot of dedication to get here. While many of you were resting or



visiting colleges over MEA Break, these girls were here, on campus and working hard."

The Stars had the perfect mix of experience, youth, talent, and motivation. Senior captains Chloe Sandness, Madden Smith, and Steph Goedde and junior captain Audrey Garton kept the team focused throughout the tournament run. Marshak said, "They felt like they had something to prove after being so close so many times before, and prove it they did."

Success Off the Field

The Stars are not only dedicated to their sport; the team commits to their coursework as well. The 22 players on the varsity team hold an average grade

point average of 3.66. Additionally, senior Kate Van Sloun and junior Ingrid Kuhfuss were named to the All-Section Academic Team. Principal Heidi Foley shared, "This team's on-field and off-field accomplishments are remarkable. As students, they hold very high standards in order to achieve a 3.66 average GPA. This is a wonderful example of the dedicated student-athletes at AHA."

To close out the season, the Stars will take a break from their well-deserved celebrations to complete the team's Faith in Action service project together, making blankets for those in need.


and for moving us to Richfield 91 years ago. Second, this year we mark 50 years of coeducation. God has been so generous with Holy Angels!

2022 Hall of Fame Inductees

Holy Angels inducted five new members into our Activities Hall of Fame. They are Fred Wroge, Randy Nelson, Kerry Graczyk Marshall '93, Kelly Graczyk Newlin '97 and Jay Barriball '06.

Jay Barribal '06 was recognized for his outstanding hockey and baseball careers. Jay played a leadership role on the Class AA State Hockey Championship team in 2005, earned First-Team All-State hockey honors twice, and received the Metro Hockey Player of the Year award in 2006. He also earned all-conference honors three times in baseball. Jay played hockey for the Gophers, where he recorded over 130 points. He then played for three years in the St. Louis Blues organization.

Kerry Graczyk Marshall '93 was recognized for her outstanding dance career. In high school, Kerry was a State medalist four times. As Holy Angels coach, Kerry led the Starliners to the State Tournament multiple times with her team finishing 2nd in high kick in 2010 and 3rd in 2011. She was inducted into the Minnesota Association of Dance Teams Hall of Fame in 2015.

Randy Nelson was recognized for his over forty seasons of coaching and teaching at Academy of Holy Angels and the significant accomplishments of his boys golf program, which included eight State appearances and three State Championships (1994, 1998, 1999). Randy also touched the lives of thousands of AHA students through his dedicated, thoughtful teaching and coaching style.

Kelly Graczyk Newlin '97 was recognized for her outstanding dance career. In high school, Kelly helped lead the Starliners to a top three State finish three times. In college, Kelly's team at Minnesota State University, Mankato claimed two National Dance Team Titles (1999, 2000). As Holy Angels coach, Kelly led the Starliners to the State Tournament multiple times, with her team finishing 2nd in high kick in 2010 and 3rd in 2011. Kelly earned Minnesota Coach of the Year honors in 2009.

Fred Wroge was recognized for his outstanding high school coaching career in Stars softball, which included a Class AA State Championship in 2000, a Class A State runner up in 1999, and a Minnesota State Coach of the Year honor in 2000. AHA also honors Fred for the many ways he has supported Holy Angels as an ambassador and bus driver.



A Promise Fulfilled

Mary's Falenczykowski Tanghe's '62 grandparents were immigrants from Poland and Czechoslovakia. Mary's father Casimir learned English when he was eight years old. He was determined to succeed in America and his dream was to fly airplanes. After high school he enlisted in the US Army, hoping to become a pilot. However, he didn't have the needed educational background from his small country school, so he was not selected for pilot training. So instead, he served as an aviation radio operator and upon his discharge from the service he was able to take flying lessons and become a licensed pilot on his own time. Casimir achieved his dream when he was hired by Northwest Airlines in 1942, shortly after his marriage to Susan Sestak.

On his way home from that early interview at Northwest Airlines, he and a friend drove west down a dirt road called 66th street. As he and his friend approached Nicollet Avenue he noticed a stately and beautiful building that seemed to grow right up out of the corn fields. As he looked at its beautiful front façade and the fledgling trees on the front lawn, he asked his friend what the building was. His friend replied that it was a newly built all-girls Catholic school called the Academy of the Holy Angels.

Casimir's response to his friend was "If I ever have a daughter. I will send her there." Mary was born in 1944. The Falenzykowskis raised their five children in Richfield, a stone's throw further west from where Casimir made that promise. And all five of the children attended St. Peter's Catholic grade school and Mary went on to attend Holy Angels Academy.

Casimir went on to become one of the first 747 captains for Northwest Airlines. The cockpit of one of those first NWA 747's that he flew is now on display at the Smithsonian National Museum of Air and Space.

Mary, the oldest, excelled at school, having a keen eye and plenty of ability in the sciences. She graduated in the AHA Class of 1962. Mary benefitted from the education she received at AHA and from the excellence of her wonderful, talented teachers, including Sister Irenaeus, Sister Mary Aloysius and Sister Marie Richard.

After high school, Mary went to the College of St. Catherine and later to the University of Minnesota Medical School. Both Mary and husband Jan were medical doctors and worked together for many years. Mary was a general practitioner and Jan a gastroenterologist. They raised six boys in Edina.

The Mary Falenczkowski Tanghe '62 and Jan Tanghe Scholarship

In the Fall of 2022, Mary and Jan visited Holy Angels to set up a need-based scholarship to help high-need students from Blessed Trinity grade school who, without financial support, could not afford the tuition at AHA. Their gift will provide significant financial support annually for five Holy Angels students. Mary and Jan have asked the AHA scholarship committee to be on the lookout for students who they themselves (or whose parents) prioritize a service career in disability services, the military, law enforcement, fire fighters, first responders, or health care.

The Jan and Mary Falenczykowski Tanghe's '62 scholarship is one of over 35 named scholarships that provide much-needed financial assistance to our awesome STARS!

The call was unexpected but the news was very good - and it came with a special story. The alumna on the line called to let us know that she and her husband had made provisions in their will for Holy Angels. The amount of the gift would be significant, and the thoughts of how this future gift would someday benefit AHA students was overwhelming.

Taking it all in, I asked this alumna what motivated her to help AHA in this extraordinary way. She told me that she was the youngest in a family with several daughters. Her older sisters all attended AHA. Her father was a physician in Minneapolis and for many years he attended to the medical needs of the CSJ sisters. He did so without charge to them.

Unfortunately, her father died before she was old enough to enroll at AHA. The CSJ community wanted her to follow her sisters at AHA. Thus, in appreciation for her father's many years of service to them, she was able to attend AHA, without payment of tuition. She was very pleased with her AHA education, having graduated more than 60 years ago. She also made many friendships that continue to this day. In addition to her annual gifts, she wanted to provide a more substantial legacy expressing her gratitude to AHA. She went on to say that recently she has had the pleasure of many visits to the campus where she has been a spectator to the activities of two of her grandchildren who attend AHA.

In my work at Holy Angels, it's been incredible to witness those who give generously to ensure that the school continues to thrive. Many of these good people share with us that they invest in AHA due the gratitude they have for the education they or their children received.

The AHA Legacy Society was officially established in 2004 to recognize those who had made this commitment known. Since that time, over 100 donors have joined. Over the years, these gifts have funded need-based scholarships, capital projects (like the 2021 iCenter for STEM Education), and have recently played a role in building our permanent endowment, which was established in 2014.

What do legacy gifts do for Holy Angels and for our students?

Here are some ways:

- First, when legacy gifts are placed in AHA's permanent endowment, they have the power to ensure that our mission will remain active for generations to come. It puts AHA in a solid place where, despite changes to economic conditions, trends in education, fluctuations in enrollment, and the storms and challenges that inevitably arise - our school will sustain and continue to thrive.
- Second, legacy gifts often help to ensure that students from middle or lower-income families may access the incredible Holy Angels education.

• Last, legacy gifts allow AHA to keep our beautiful French Gothic building and campus in excellent condition and able to effectively serve the next generations of students.

My wife Annie and I decided to join the Legacy Society in 2017 because making provisions for our alma mater is of great importance to us. Using a codicil (amendment) to our current will, the process was straightforward and simple.

The Class of 1997 celebrated their 25-year reunion in August.



Generations of Bachmans beautify Holy Angels

"Go, my children, with my blessing, never alone. Grow in love and love by serving, joyful and free." (These beautiful words are etched on the stones that line the newly designed flower bed)

A heartfelt thank you to current parent Karen Bachman Thull for her generous gift in redesigning and providing the many beautiful trees and perennials for our historic front sign flower bed. Karen is the fourth generation of five in her family to help AHA's grounds look beautiful. Below is a reflection from Karen about the special connection between Holy Angels and Bachmans, two of the oldest organizations in our area.



Bachman's began as a vegetable farm at 60th and Lyndale in 1885 in what used to be Richfield. Henry Bachman Sr., my great, great grandfather, instilled the values of hard work, faith and community with his growing family and business. Two generations later, my grandfather, Lloyd Bachman, used to tell me stories of helping plant tulip bulbs and maintain the garden beds of the Sisters of St. Joseph at the Academy of the Holy Angels. He enjoyed the short jaunt over to the campus at 66th and Nicollet to visit with the Sisters and to meet the girls who were there. Grandpa maintained our vegetable farm with his siblings and cousins, but his passion was flowers. It brought him joy to help the Sisters of St. Joseph and others grow beautiful blooms.

There are so many reasons to celebrate the Academy of Holy Angels - great students, dedicated families, incredible teachers and staff, a remarkable, historical campus, the list goes on - this is one way that my family could help bring beauty to life and continue to celebrate our vibrant community. The stones in front of the monument sign are etched with lyrics from one of my favorite hymns. It reads: "Go, my children, with my blessing, never alone. Grow in love and love by serving, joyful and free." That is my hope for all the families that have the opportunity



From the President

Dear Academy of Holy Angels Community Members,

I am excited and honored to be able to share with you the 2021-22 Annual Report included in this Communiqué. What this report provides is an opportunity to share the metrics of your support and how each and every gift truly impacts the lives of our students, faculty, and staff. The achievements of our students and faculty this past year has been remarkable, both in and out of the classroom. The typical benchmarks of student progress remain high with standardized testing and Advanced Placement (AP) involvement reaching beyond previous years. Specifically:

- During the 2021-22 school year, 290 students took 561 AP exams;
- The class of 2022 received \$16.1 million in scholarships and accepted \$5.4 million in college scholarships;
- In 2022, one AHA student was named a National Merit Scholar and six additional students were named Commended Scholars. One student was named a National Hispanic Scholar;
- The composite ACT test score for the Class of 2022 was 26.1 which is considerably higher than both state and national averages; and,
- 96% of our students participated in co-curricular activities highlighting school involvement.

AHA's recognition as a School of Distinction by Cognia, a global education accreditation agency, has validated our system-wide efforts as we strive to be a leader in valuesbased college preparatory education. Cognia represents 39,000 public and private schools worldwide, setting standards for school assessment, improvement, student engagement, effective learning environments, and data uses. This recognition is impressive, but more impressive is the support by every member of the AHA community who invests in our school partnered with the dedication of our faculty. The difference they make and the impact they have is paramount to the success of our students.

The 2021-22 audited financial results once again tell the story of a fiscally sound institution. For the 11th year in succession, Academy of Holy Angels has presented a balanced budget and through strong financial stewardship, showed an excess at year end. Our debt service has been slowly reduced, and we project a debtfree budget in the 2024-25 school term. The school's Vision 2026 Strategic Plan highlights a number of focus areas, including increasing financial capacity to assist families in making an AHA education affordable through enhanced financial aid. In addition, keeping class sizes at minimums to enrich the learning opportunities for students is key. Watch for a new Campus Master Plan draft that is currently in committee work and will be available for public consumption in 2023.

In closing, thank you for your faithful support of Academy of Holy Angels. May God bless each of you and your family this Christmas season and in the year to come.


